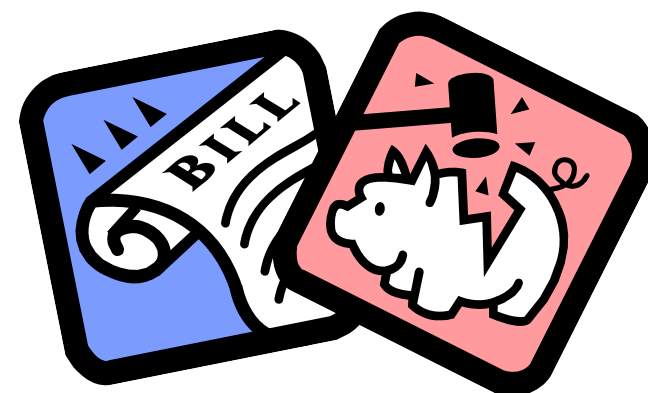

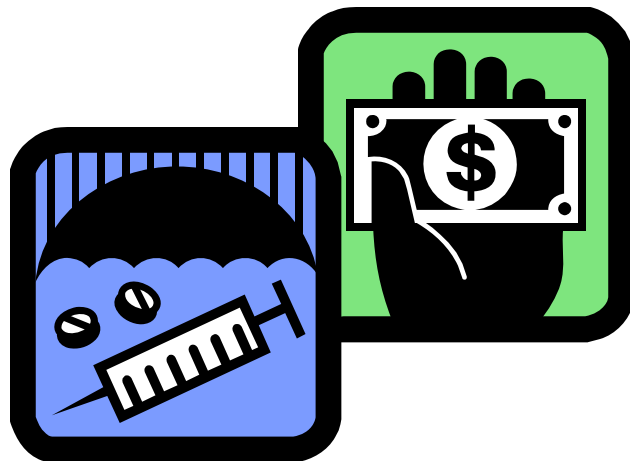
Resource Counsellors – professional social workers with the Department of Psychosocial Resources

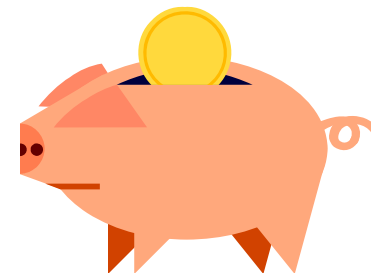
